



## Consultative sessions held with High Courts for effective and timely utilization of AJDF funding: short-term schemes to be finalized annually



The Governing Body, Access to Justice Development Fund has stressed upon timely utilization of the released amount to High Courts and remarked that LJCP Secretariat can play an active role. In this regard, a cap of 80% utilization for subsequent releases has been fixed to ensure timely and effective utilization of funds.

Consequently, consultative sessions with High Courts were arranged by the management of the Fund and it was resolved that efforts would be made to complete such projects within the same financial year. The Secretary LJCP remarked that the scope and funding priorities of Access to Justice Development Fund would be reviewed keeping in view the changing requirements, advances in information technology and priorities of judicial leadership across the country to help

the judiciary in winning trust of the people through efficiency and transparency in delivering justice in the age of technology.

Moreover, the Secretary LJCP directed the AJDF team to improve their liaison with the respective High Courts for preparation of work plans so that the release of funds could extend maximum benefit to the litigants. Furthermore, Secretary LJCP, stressed upon the need to take measures to create awareness regarding free legal aid under AJDF.

He also highlighted the need to link project time lines and release of funds from AJDF to secure endowment investment profit to the possible extent.
